APPLYING FOR ADMISSION TO MARIETTA COLLEGE

Statement of Admission Philosophy

Marietta College seeks students who are prepared to meet the challenge of a rigorous college curriculum. The Admissions Committee considers the applicant's high school record, including the college preparatory courses taken, grades received, and scores on national examinations. Furthermore, it evaluates each applicant's energy, motivation, potential, emotional maturity, seriousness of purpose and attitude toward learning. Each application is read carefully.

Additionally, we seek students who are more than just academically prepared. The College prides itself on its strong sense of community and the diverse backgrounds and varied interests of its students. The Committee considers the ways in which each applicant will bring quality and vitality to the Marietta community. Such things as extracurricular activities, non-academic interests, and creativity all become part of the admissions decision.

Marietta College is a member of the National Association of College Admissions Counselors (NACAC) and endorses the Statement of Principles of Good Practice.

The Admission Calendar

You may apply between **May 1 of your junior year and April 15 of your senior year**; admission after April 15 is offered on a space available basis. We encourage you to file your application as early as possible. If you wish to be considered for academic scholarships you should apply no later than **March 1**. We will notify you by letter if any required portion of your application is missing. You will be advised of the Admissions Committee's decision within one month of the date your application is complete. A Marietta College catalog will be mailed to you upon admission to the

College. If you are admitted to Marietta and plan to enroll, you must submit a **\$200 advanced deposit by May 1**. Deposits made in advance of this date are refundable until May 1 if you select another college or university. **Earlier dated deposits will have priority consideration for residence hall preferences and freshman seminar selection.**

Guidance Counselor Report Form and Transcript

Fill in the top portion of the **Guidance Counselor Report** before giving it to your guidance or college counselor. He or she should complete and return this form directly to Marietta College along with your Secondary School Transcript. An envelope is provided for the return of this information. If you enroll at Marietta, your secondary school **transcript** will become part of your official file and be available for your review; your Guidance Counselor Report is confidential, and will not.

Admission Tests

You are required to submit test scores from either the SAT I or the ACT. You may ask that your scores be sent to us directly or they may be reported on your secondary school transcript. Marietta's **SAT number is 1444**, our **ACT number is 3290**. Your application will not be reviewed until the results of your SAT I or ACT are received. Although not required, if you have taken or plan to take SAT II Subject Tests, please indicate so on your application. SAT II tests are optional; however, these scores are useful to us in advising, course selection, and placement. If your state requires that you pass one or more **proficiency tests** in order to receive a high school diploma, your school will be asked to confirm that you have passed these tests.

Teacher Evaluation (optional)

After completing the top portion of the form, please give it to a **teacher who has taught you in an academic subject during your junior or senior year**. If you wish to submit additional recommendations, you may have them write to us directly. If you matriculate at Marietta, these evaluations will not become part of your official file.

Essay

Marietta requires that you submit an essay as part of your application. We give you **four options** from which to choose so you may pick the one you find most interesting. Be careful to type or write legibly.

Application Fee

A **fee of \$25** must accompany your application. Your check or money order should be made payable to Marietta College. This fee is not refundable. If it represents a financial hardship to you and your family, please ask your guidance or college counselor to submit a request for an **application fee waiver** to Marietta on your behalf.

McDonough Leadership Program

The McDonough Leadership Program is one of the most respected programs in America. You may participate in the program and seek an academic **minor** or **certificate program**. The Program can be combined with any major at the college.

Students who wish to be considered for the McDonough Leadership Program should complete the special application enclosed with this Marietta College application.

Financial Aid

The Marietta College scholarship and financial aid programs are designed to make a Marietta education accessible to all students.

To apply for need-based assistance, new freshmen must provide:

- The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

The FAFSA is available in December at your high school guidance office or by contacting the Marietta College Office of Financial Aid.

Upon submission to the appropriate processor, the FAFSA is analyzed and the results forwarded to the College. The **Marietta College code for (FAFSA) is 003073**. You are strongly encouraged to complete and submit all financial aid materials as soon as possible after January 1. To ensure full consideration for financial aid please submit all materials by March 1.

Scholarships (In General)

No additional application is necessary in order to be considered for Marietta merit-based scholarships.

To ensure full consideration for scholarships please submit your application for admission by March 1.
